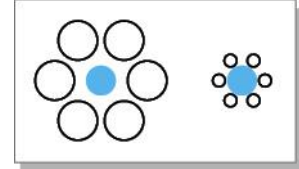

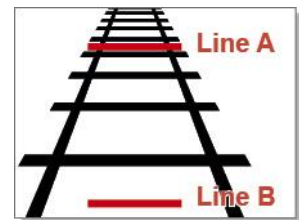
The Moon Illusion

Have you ever noticed that the full moon looks bigger when it's near the horizon than when it is high above? 47 In fact there are, but the question is: which one is right?

One of the possible reasons given by Andrew Vanden Heuvel is the Ebbinghaus illusion. The idea is that two circles of the same size will look different because of the size of the things around them. Take a look at the circles in the picture. 48 In this way, maybe the moon looks bigger near the horizon because it's next to much smaller things, like trees, houses, and buildings. Then when the moon is higher up, it is in the middle of the vast night sky, so it looks much smaller.



49 given by Andrew is the Ponzo illusion. The idea behind this is that our brains will tell us that something 50 larger than it really is when it is closer to the horizon. For example, the two red lines in the picture are the same size, but Line A might look longer because it is closer to the horizon.



In short, there is still a heated debate over the real reason for the moon illusion. As long as you can see the moon in the night sky, it will keep happening.
