



Fast-food places can be a little tricky. You'd think chicken would be a better choice than beef — but at McDonald's, the chicken sandwich has more fat and calories than a regular hamburger.

Luckily, most fast-food places post nutrition facts on their websites so you can see what's in their food before you go. Look for foods that are low in fat, calories, sugar, and salt and high in fiber, vitamins, calcium, and iron.

If you can't find this information online, here are some tips for making healthier choices. Pick smaller grilled items instead of fried food. Choose portion sizes that are close to what you eat at home, not the really big sizes. Instead of fries, you could have a side salad, but be careful with the dressing. Watch out for things like bacon, cheese, and mayo, as they can add a lot of calories. And when it comes to drinks, it's best to go for water or low-fat milk.

Mark Twain is a very famous American writer. *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer* is a book he wrote, and so is its follow-up, *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn*. But did you know that Mark Twain is not his real name? It's actually his pen name. There are many interesting facts about Mark Twain. Let's take a look at a few of them.

Mark Twain was born on November 30, 1835 and was named as Samuel Langhorne Clemens. He grew up in Missouri, the sixth of seven children. When he was born, a famous comet called Halley's Comet had just passed by close to the sun. The comet is in an orbit and returns close to Earth about every 75 years.

Before he became a writer, he worked as a boat captain and a miner. He was an inventor, too. He invented a board game! The name by which he became most famous came from his days sailing on the Mississippi River. "Mark Twain" means 12 feet of water to sailors.

The American writer was a big fan of science, and so was Nikola Tesla. The two became good friends. He also loved cats very much. He always said that cats were so much better than people that he'd rather live with them. He often rented cats to stay with him when he traveled and is known to have had 19 cats living with him at one time!

Also, Mark Twain predicted his own death. One year before Halley's Comet was due to come back, he said "I came in with Halley's Comet in 1835. It is coming again next year, and I expect to go out with it." He died on April 21, 1910, one day after the comet had passed by.
